**Skagens Kunstmuseer & Baghaven inviterer til
fernisering på udstillingen & kåring af vinderværk**

Fællesskab, mad & natur er en udstilling og konkurrence med fokus på samspillet mellem mad, kunst og natur. Udstillingen er en del af projektet UP-CREATE - et EU strategisk partnerskab mellem Aalborg Universitet, Alchemist Taste Lab og fem europæiske kulturinstitutioner, heriblandt Skagens Kunstmuseer.

Under overskriften *Fællesskab, mad & natur* har Skagens Kunstmuseer og Baghaven inviteret seks aspirerende unge kunstnere fra Billedkunstnerisk Grundkursus i Aalborg (BGK-Nord) ind i museets samling og ud at høste skagensmalernes landskaber. Formålet var at give de unge et nyt blik for landskabet og naturen som ressource – for såvel kunst- som smagsoplevelser. Et blik og et møde, de unge kunstnere efterfølgende har omsat til seks individuelle og meget forskellige værker, som alle indgår i UP-CREATE – konkurrencen. Den vindende kunstner inviteres til en international workshop, der vises på en session på kunstbiennalen i Venedig i november 2022.

Vinderværket kan opleves i Baghavens Atelier frem til den 25. september i Baghavens åbningstid.

Community, Food and Nature is an exhibition and competition that focuses on the interaction between food, art, and nature. The exhibition is part of the project UP-CREATE - an EU strategic partnership between Aalborg University, Alchemist Taste Lab and five European cultural institutions, amongst these Art Museums of Skagen.

Under the headline *Community, Food and Nature*, Art Museums of Skagen and Baghaven have invited six young artists from the Visual Arts Basic Course in Aalborg to experience the museum's collection and to harvest the sights of the landscapes of the Skagen painters. The aim was to give the young people a new perspective of the landscape and nature as resources - for both art and taste experiences. A meeting which the young artists have subsequently converted into six individual and very different artworks. The artworks are part of the UP-CREATE competition. The winning artist is invited to an international workshop at the Art Biennale in Venice in November 2022.

The winning artwork can be experienced at the Atelier at Baghaven until and including Sunday the 25th of September during the opening hours of Baghaven.
